Where does bboxx install solar panels?

Bboxx supplies solar home systems in 12 countries across sub-Saharan Africa and in Pakistan and a spokesperson for the Instinctif PR firm said an announcement about moves into new markets would be made "in due course". Bboxx installs a solar panel which can power up to five lights, a television, radio, torch or a 12 V battery.
