Do electric ranges have storage drawers?

Freestanding electric ranges have storage drawers with double wall construction. They have two pieces of steel separated by approximately 1/2" of space, which helps to prevent exterior dents from occurring when placing heavy objects in the drawer. All other ranges have single wall construction storage drawers.

Is it safe to live near a stove?

If you have many appliances, along with condiments and ingredients, occupying luxury real estate near the stove, you may be inadvertently creating food or fire risks. Placing items that you regularly use, such as cooking oils and spices, nearby may be convenient, but it may not be the safest choice.

How does an electric stove work?

This type of stove uses electricity to cook your food and plugs into a 220-volt outlet. This is a larger, more robust outlet than the 120-volt standard, usually seen in U.S. households only in kitchens and laundry rooms. When you turn on an electric stove, the cooker coils glow orange.

Is it safe to keep a pan in the oven drawer?

Your pans and bakeware--like baking sheets, skillet, casserole dishes, pizza stones--are safe if kept in the oven drawer. As long as they are made of material that is oven-safe, they will not be damaged under the heating element. You can also keep extra cooling racks, oven racks or bulky kitchen utensils here if you are pressed for space.

Electric stoves also take a longer time to heat up compared to gas or induction ranges. If you have a smooth top electric cooktop, avoid using cast iron pans, as they'll scratch the surface.
