

# Can sea hares be dried and stored

Why do sea hares have a sluggish shell?

Sea hares lack a well-developed shell to afford them mechanical protection from predation and they are sluggish, so they are unable to use armor or speed to avoid fast predators such as crabs or fish. They have evolved other means of protection, including crypsis, large size, and an impressive array of chemical defenses (Figure 1).

Where do dried seahorses come from?

These desiccated seahorses have been used as ingredients in TCM and exported mainly from China and Thailand. The CITES trade database also showed that the majority of dried seahorses came from wild populations rather than captive-bred ones. However, the species composition of dried seahorses in the Taiwan market has never been ascertained.

Are dried seahorse markets adherence to CITES recommendations?

We assessed adherence to CITES recommendations using DNA barcoding and size measurements to compare two prominent U.S. dried seahorse markets: (1) traditional Chinese medicine (TCM), and (2) non-medicinal e-commerce and coastal curio (ECC). We also estimated U.S. import abundance from CITES records.

How many dried seahorses have been imported?

Reported CITES imports of dried seahorses totaled approximately 972,446 individuals. Reported import abundance is presented for each species identified in this study (Fig 3, *H. comes* was not reported on CITES), and also includes undesignated species imports (*Hippocampus* spp.) and species not found in our study (*Hippocampus* other).

How much ink does a sea hare release?

Regarding its all-or-nothing aspect, research has shown that the first suprathreshold stimulus received by a sea hare with full ink glands induces the sea hare to release approximately half of its ink, and each subsequent stimulus causes it to release 30-50% of its remaining ink.

How are dried seahorses classified?

Because dried seahorses have exorbitant prices and a detailed morphological examination was not possible on the spot, during collection, dried seahorses were classified roughly into different morphological forms and one individual of each form was purchased randomly and brought back to the laboratory.
