How much energy does Algeria import?

Algeria imports very little energy as its domestic consumption is met by its own oil and natural gas production, which is heavily subsidized. Natural gas and oil account for almost all of Algeria's total primary energy consumption. Algeria's oil fields produce high quality, light, sweet crude oil with a very low sulfur content.

Algeria's geographical position near Europe provides an advantage for energy exports, particularly to Mediterranean countries. Aligning with global sustainability goals, the Algerian Ministry of Energy and Mines has set targets for electricity generation, aiming for 40% from renewable sources by 2030.

Algeria sits atop a treasure trove of hydrocarbons. For decades, oil and natural gas have been the lifeblood of the Algerian economy and helped shape the nation's geopolitical standing. When it comes to market size, Algeria has the tenth-largest proven natural gas reserves globally.

How much electricity does Algeria generate a year?

Algeria currently generates a relatively small amount of its electricity (e.g., three percent or 686 MW annually), from renewable sources, including solar (448 MW), hydro (228 MW), and wind (10 MW).

How big is Algeria's natural gas market?

When it comes to market size, Algeria has the tenth-largest proven natural gas reserves globally. It is also the world's fourth-largest gas exporter and has the world's third-largest untapped shale gas resources. Algeria ranks sixteenth in proven oil reserves and exports roughly sixty per cent of its total production.

Algeria's Sonatrach group and Spain's Cepsa kicked off Monday a project to produce green hydrogen and derivatives in the North African country.
