French company Total Eren plans to build a 50Mw solar plant in Gabon. The plant will cut emissions by 59,000 tonnes annually. Total Eren plans to develop a 50MWp solar photovoltaic (PV) plant near Gabon's capital city of Libreville. The company announced this week that it had signed a preliminary agreement with Gabonese authorities.

The project is being developed and currently owned by Total Eren. The company has a stake of 100%. Total Eren Libreville Solar PV Park is a ground-mounted solar project. The electricity generated from the plant will offset 59,000t of carbon dioxide emissions (CO₂) a year. Development status The project construction is expected to commence from ...

The Ayemé PV plant is located in the Plaine-Ayeme area of northwestern Gabon, around 30 km from the country's capital, Libreville. Solen SA Gabon, a subsidiary of Solen Renewable Dubai, built and operates the project, with an initial capacity of 11 MW, according to local media outlet L'Union .

Gabon confirms its ambition that renewable energies should constitute 85% of its energy mix by 2025. The construction in the coming months of 8 solar power plants with a cumulative production capacity of 2.2 megawatts will ultimately save 1 million litres of fuel oil per year, i.e. 2,600 tons of CO₂ and 30% of the expenses related to electricity production in Gabon.
