How many gallons can a gas tank hold?

Fire codes typically restrict gas storage at residential complexes to no more than 25 gallons. Ensure to store gasoline in approved gas tanks. Approved gas storage containers have a label or wording on the container stating that it meets specifications for portable containers for petroleum products.

How much gas storage capacity is required for a gas station?

From the data in the table, it can be seen that the cumulative minimum value of gas filling volume and production volume under normal conditions is  $-530\text{m}^3$  and the cumulative maximum value is  $300\text{m}^3$ . Therefore, the gas storage capacity required for this station is  $830\text{m}^3$  (baseline state).
