What is a solar dish?

a solar dish whose reflector comprises many regular shaped (typically square) mirror facets mounted on parabolic shaped support structures. a trapezoidal-shaped mirror panel that typically has a continuous parabolic curved surface that extends from near the center to the perimeter of the solar dish.

What are the components of a solar dish?

The dish faces the sun and must be able to move to follow its path in the sky throughout the day. A solar dish has several key subcomponents, described here as the reflector, support structure, tracking system, foundations, receiver, and receiver support (Fig. 1).
