Will Syria reshape the balance of power in the Middle East?

The Syrian government has been toppled, and its leader sent into exile, a seismic shift poised to reshape the balance of power in the Middle East. Rebels seized the capital Damascus over the weekend, having captured Homs and other smaller cities in a lightning-fast offensive that took the incumbent government by storm.

Will Syrian rebels make an advance to Aleppo after Israel weakened Hezbollah?

Hadi al-Bahra, a Syrian opposition leader representing anti-Assad groups, including the Turkey-backed Syrian National Army (SNA), said rebels felt encouraged to make an advance for Aleppo last week after Israel debilitated Hezbollah and weakened Iran's footprint in the region.
