Will solar power increase the electricity supply in the Netherlands?

In the coming years, solar power will contribute significantly to the electricity supply in the Netherlands, making a high growth rate of 10 GWp in 2023 attainable. Since 2011, the National Action Plan on Solar Power has been committed to identifying and eliminating the societal barriers of solar energy.

What is the future of solar in the Netherlands?

By the end of 2023, installed PV capacity is predicted to reach approximately 15 GW. The forecast for solar in the Netherlands is sunny. The Netherlands Environmental Assessment Agency (PBL) is expecting the nation's installed PV capacity to have grown almost fivefold from the beginning of this year until the end of the next decade.

Is the residential solar sector growing in the Netherlands?

Since 2013, the residential solar sector in the Netherlands has grown at an annual double-digit rate, and accounted for around 80% of installed capacity up to 2016.
