Pope Francis has announced plans for the Vatican City to go solar through his latest motu proprio, Fratello Sole, or Brother Sun. The pope has delegated Vatican governing bodies to work with the Italian government to build an agrivoltaics system in the lands of Santa Maria di Galeria, located outside of Rome and an extra-territory of Vatican City.

To this end, it intends to: gradually replace its own state-owned cars with electric vehicles, in order to make its car fleet carbon-neutral by 2030; implement its own recharging network in the state and extra-territorial areas by extending its use to its own employees; and ensure that its energy needs come exclusively from renewable energy ...

The Vatican has been seeking to drastically reduce its environmental impact by adopting more renewable energy sources, pursuing a goal of zero emissions by 2050 and assembling a net-zero-emissions fleet of vehicles by 2030. In 2022, The Vatican joined the 1992 United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and the 2015 Paris Agreement.
